

Winter Break Critter Camp Junior Volunteer Application

Thanks to Education Volunteers, Helen Woodward Animal Center helps both people and animals by educating children about animals. The Junior Volunteer program is both fun and hard work. Volunteers must be mature, dependable, be able to follow directions, work independently, and display introductory leadership and teamwork skills. The most successful volunteers are committed, enthusiastic and experienced with children. Volunteers should have some previous experience working with children and a desire to work with Pre K $-6^{\rm th}$ grades.

Winter Break Critter Camp will take place for three weeks; Week 1 is December 18th – 22nd; Week 2 is December 26th – 29th (NO CAMP MONDAY, 12/25); Week 3 is January 2nd – 5th (NO CAMP MONDAY, 1/01). Volunteer shifts are from 8:00am-3:30pm each day so you must be available from 8-3:30pm each day you volunteer. There are also 2 openings from 9:00am-5:00pm. We cannot accommodate partial volunteer days. This is a smaller camp; therefore, we have more flexibility with scheduling volunteer shifts. It would be great if you are available for a full week of camp but if that is not a possibility, any day(s) you are available is fine.

Applicants must be in 9^{th} – 12^{th} grade as of Fall of 2017 and between the ages of 14 – 17.

It is important to understand that the volunteer's job is working with children (not animals). Volunteers do prep work before and after class, clean up, assist with managing children's behavior, and supervise lunch & play time. Volunteers help the teacher with animal lessons, art, and games. Volunteers will be working around animals but not directly handling them.

You are not guaranteed a spot as a volunteer until the application has been received and you have been contacted via email or phone to confirm your assignment. We will hold a <u>MANDATORY</u> training session for **NEW volunteers only from 7am – 8am on Monday December 18th (if you are doing week 1); Tuesday, December 26th (if you are doing week 2); Tuesday, January 2nd (if you are doing week 3) where you will receive a Volunteer T-Shirt. New volunteers MUST come to this training or they will not be permitted to volunteer. Past volunteers may wear the red Critter Camp Volunteer Shirt only. If you do not have one, we will provide you with one.**
