Thanks to Education Volunteers, the Helen Woodward Animal Center helps both people and animals by educating children about pet responsibility. The Junior Volunteer program is both fun and hard work. Volunteers must be mature, dependable, be able to follow directions, work independently, and display introductory leadership and teamwork skills. The most successful volunteers are committed, enthusiastic and experienced with children. Volunteers should have some previous experience working with children and a desire to work with Pre K – 6th grade.

JV Volunteer shifts are from **8:00-3:30pm.** We cannot accommodate partial volunteer days. There are also 2 openings from 9:00am – 5:00pm if you would prefer – just let me know.

*Applicants must be in 9^{th} – 12^{th} grade as of Fall of 2017 and between the ages of 14 and 17 years old.

It is important to understand that the **volunteer's job is working with children (not animals).** Volunteers do prep work before and after class, clean up, assist with managing children's behavior, and supervise lunch & play time. Volunteers help the teacher with animal lessons, art, and games. **Volunteers will be working around animals but not directly handling them**.
