

Thanksgiving Break Critter Camp Junior Volunteer Application November 19th – 21st

Thanks to Education Volunteers, Helen Woodward Animal Center helps both people and animals by educating children about animals. The Junior Volunteer program is both fun and hard work. Volunteers must be mature, dependable, be able to follow directions, work independently, and display introductory leadership and teamwork skills. The most successful volunteers are committed, enthusiastic and experienced with children. Volunteers should have some previous experience working with children and a desire to work with PreK $-6^{\rm th}$ grade.

Thanksgiving Break Critter Camp will take place on November 19th, 20th, and 21st. Volunteer shifts are from 8:00am-3:30pm each day so you must be available from 8-3:30pm each day you volunteer. There are also 2 openings from 9:00am – 5:00pm. We cannot accommodate partial volunteer days. This is a smaller camp; therefore, we have more flexibility with scheduling volunteer shifts. It would be great if you are available all 3 of camp days but if that is not a possibility, any day(s) you are available is fine.

Applicants must be in $9^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade as of Fall of 2018 and between the ages of 14 - 17.

It is important to understand that the volunteer's job is working with children (not animals). Volunteers do prep work before and after class, clean up, assist with managing children's behavior, and supervise lunch & play time. Volunteers help the teacher with animal lessons, crafts, and games. Volunteers will be working around animals but not directly handling them.

You are not guaranteed a spot as a volunteer until the application has been received and you have been contacted via email or phone to confirm your assignment. We will hold a <u>MANDATORY</u> training session for **NEW volunteers only on Monday November 19**th **from 7am-8am** where you will receive a Volunteer T-Shirt. **Please note that you will NOT be able to volunteer without coming to this training!** Past volunteers may wear the red Critter Camp Volunteer Shirt only. If you do not have one, we will provide you with one.
