

One of the fun aspects of our lessons are the arena props we use, such as bean bags, stuffed toys, and sensory rings. Along with being fun and engaging, they also allow students to work on fine motor skills, sensory processing, multi-step planning, and communication skills.

One recently donated prop that has been a great asset in communications is our new chalkboard. The chalkboard has found many uses in lessons. For some students, it's a visual map of their lesson plan, allowing them to understand what's expected and help to execute it. For students with auditory or verbal challenges, it's a way to increase communication between them and their lesson team. Many thanks to our Sunday volunteer, Deb, for donating this great tool!



As you may know, our average lesson costs over \$140 to provide, while our fee to riders is much less than that. Along with grants and generous donors, one way we fundraise to help cover the difference is with our twice a year tack sale.
