

February 2020 Critter Camp Junior Volunteer Application February 10th – 14th and February 17th – 21st

Thanks to Education Volunteers, the Helen Woodward Animal Center helps both people and animals by educating children about pet responsibility. The Junior Volunteer program is both fun and hard work. Volunteers must be mature, dependable, be able to follow directions, work independently, and display introductory leadership and teamwork skills. The most successful volunteers are committed, enthusiastic and experienced with children. Volunteers should have some previous experience working with children and a desire to work with Pre K -6^{th} grade.

Regular Volunteer shifts are from **8:00-3:30**, **Monday – Friday** and volunteers must be available from 8-3:30pm each day they volunteer. We cannot accommodate partial volunteer days. We also have a few **extended care shifts**, which are from **9:00-5:00**. This is a smaller camp; therefore we have more flexibility with scheduling volunteer shifts. It would be great if you are available all five camp days. If that is not a possibility, any day(s) you are available is fine, <u>for this camp only</u>. (Summer camp requires a week-long commitment.)

*Applicants must be in 9^{th} – 12^{th} grade as of Fall of 2019 and be between ages of 14-17.

It is important to understand that the **volunteer's job is working with children (not animals).** Volunteers do prep work before and after class, clean up, assist with managing children's behavior, and supervise lunch & play time. Volunteers help the teacher with animal lessons, art, and games. **Volunteers will be working around animals but not directly handling them**. You can get a letter for verification of hours for Community Service – Just email Laurie for it.

Volunteers must fill out the attached application and return to Laurie Doyle, Volunteer Supervisor. Applications can be faxed to 858-756-0605, or emailed to Lauried@animalcenter.org. *You are not guaranteed a spot as a volunteer until the application has been received and you have been contacted via email or phone to confirm your assignment.* If you do not receive confirmation within three days of submitting your application, please contact Laurie at 858-756-4117 ext. 370.

If you are a NEW CAMP VOLUNTEER and are volunteering between 2/10 – 2/14, you MUST come at 7am for training on 2/10. If you are a NEW CAMP VOLUNTEER and are volunteering any between 2/17-2/21, you MUST come at 7am on Monday 2/17 for training. These trainings are mandatory (you will NOT be able to volunteer without attending) and this is when you will receive your red volunteer t-shirt. Past camp volunteers must wear the red Critter Camp Volunteer Shirt. If you do not have one, we will provide you with a new one.
