

### Summer Critter Camp 2021 Application Deadline is April 26, 2021

Thanks to Education Volunteers, Helen Woodward Animal Center helps both people and animals by educating children about pet responsibility. The Junior Volunteer program is both fun and hard work. Volunteers must be mature, dependable, be able to follow directions, work independently, and display introductory leadership and teamwork skills. The most successful volunteers are committed, enthusiastic and experienced with children. Volunteers should have some previous experience working with children and a desire to work with  $PreK - 6^{th}$  grades.

It is important to understand that the **volunteer's job is working with children, not animals.** Volunteers will be working around animals, but not directly handling them. Volunteers do prep work before and after class, clean up, assist with managing children's behavior, and supervise lunch & play time. Volunteers help the teacher with animal lessons, crafts, and games.

COVID-19 policies must be followed by staff, volunteers, and campers

- We check and record temperatures each morning, check in with a staff member to be temped.
- Masks are required and must be worn at all times, unless you are eating or drinking.
- We will maintain 6 ft. distance whenever possible.
- Please stay home if you or anyone in your household has a fever or displays symptoms like coughing, sore throat or headache.
- Wash hands for 20 seconds before eating.
- Use hand sanitizer before and after touching shared items, including animal carriers.

### <u>Hours</u>

- Volunteer shifts are 8:00am-3:30pm Monday-Friday
- Some extended care shifts from 9:00am-5:00pm Monday-Friday

Volunteers must be available the entire shift each day, <u>partial shifts are not possible</u>, and volunteers are <u>required</u> to work for an entire week. Volunteers can work for more than one week if desired, provided there is room. After volunteering you can contact Laurie about a letter for verification of Community Service hours.

### **Requirements**

- Applicants must be in 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade as of Fall of 2021 and between ages of 14-17

<u>Mandatory</u> training session for new and returning volunteers. To be consistent in providing a safe and quality camp experience and to be fair to all volunteers, we will not make exceptions. Failure to attend this training means you will NOT be able to volunteer.

Applicants should select a training date based on the month that they will be volunteering (for example: if you are volunteering at any time in June, select the May training date). During your training new volunteers will receive their volunteer T-shirt. If returning volunteers need one, we will provide it.

### **Application Process**

- Complete and return the attached application. Due to Covid restrictions, we can only accommodate a very limited number of volunteers each week. Week preferences are granted on a first come, first served basis. Can be emailed, faxed, or mailed (details below).
- 2. Scheduling: please give us **at least three** options of volunteer work week choices. Due to the challenges of scheduling so many volunteers, if you have only one week available, your chance of getting a spot is



significantly diminished. Transportation is your responsibility. We consider schedule requests for carpool reasons, but there are no guarantees. Friends are not placed in the same class.

- 3. New JV volunteers must complete questionnaire at end of application. Please submit with application.
- 4. **New and returning volunteers** please let us know: <u>How did you hear about this volunteer opportunity?</u> <u>Please be as specific as possible! ( school, friend, organization, website, etc) – thanks!</u>
- 5. Fees: New volunteers and returning volunteers have different fees (cost detailed below). This payment is non-refundable. This covers processing, administrative work and the new volunteer T-shirt.
- 6. We will email you to verify that we have received your application. If you do not receive a confirmation within two weeks of sending your application, email <u>lauried@animalcenter.org</u> to inquire. Please add <u>animalcenter.org</u> to your allowed email lists so it doesn't end up in your spam folder.
- 7. Training is required for all volunteers, including returning volunteers. You will receive an email with your training session and work week assignment by May 3. If you do not receive these assignments by then, email Laurie to inquire. Your volunteer assignment will be cancelled if you do not attend a training session.
